May Meeting



Our recitalist for our May 29th, 4:00 pm meeting is James Roman, a graduate of Westminster Choir College of Rider University in Princeton, NJ, where he earned a dual undergraduate degree in Organ Performance and Sacred Music and is currently pursuing a master's degree in Organ Performance. Previously a student of Joel Krott and Ken Cowan, he now studies with renowned organist Alan Morrison and has had additional studies with Grethe Krogh in Copenhagen, Denmark. He is currently the Church Music Intern at the First Presbyterian Church of Moorestown in Moorestown, NJ. In 2006, 2009, and 2015 he participated in the FPC choir tours of Denmark and Sweden. Recently, he has performed with the Westminster Symphonic Choir at Philadelphia's Kimmel Center and New York City's Carnegie Hall singing Verdi's Requiem, Beethoven's Symphony No. 9, Rachmaninoff's The Bells, Orff's Carmina Burana, Mahler's Symphony No. 2, Brahms' Ein deutsches

Requiem, and the NYC premiere of Christopher Rouse's Requiem. He is also a member of Westminster Williamson Voices under the direction of Dr. James Jordan. He has given numerous recitals in the New Jersey area as well as having performed in the 2013 AGO Region III Convention in Winchester, VA. In 2013, he was the co-winner of the Joan Lippincott Organ Competition for Excellence in Organ Performance. He currently resides in Princeton, New Jersey.

Mr. Roman's progam will include the following works: Fantasia super Komm, heiliger Geist, BWV 561, J. S. Bach; Psalm-Prelude Set 1, No. 3, Herbert Howells; Deux Esquisses, Op. 41, Marcel Dupré; Scherzo, Op. 2, Maurice Duruflé; Sonata Eroïca, Op. 94, Jospeh Jongen. Some additional works will be featured as well.

Organ Student Scholarships

The Lehigh Valley Chapter is in the process of creating a fresh approach to the awarding of organ student scholarships. The scholarship is intended for advanced piano students who are interested in becoming beginning organ students. The chapter has a limited amount designated for scholarship funding. The process is now based on an application form and a letter of interest from the student and a letter of recommendation from the sponsoring private piano teacher. The scholarship application form is available on the LVAGO web site. As previously, the scholarship winner will receive 10 private organ lessons with a qualified LVAGO teacher and a one year chapter membership in the Lehigh Valley Chapter. A panel of LVAGO members will review the application and letters and decide whether or not to award the scholarship. If you have an interested beginning organ student, consider applying for the scholarship. Also share the opportunity with other piano teachers who are not AGO members.
